a) **January 29, 2014**

**4. JOHNSTON ROAD PROJECT WALK**

Staff provided a map indicating the changes requested by the Task Force at the January 29, 2014 meeting.

The Task Force walked the route of the proposed changes on Johnston Road, from North Bluff to Russell Avenue.

**5. PROJECT COST ESTIMATES**

Staff advised that the City of White Rock has \$340,000 set aside for sidewalk improvements from North Bluff to Russell Avenue, east side only. The cost estimate for sidewalk improvements, east and west side of Johnston Road from North Bluff to Russell Avenue, including light poles is \$725,000, not including hanging basket poles.

Staff will review the Sewer and Drainage Master Plan to see if repairs to sewers may be required. Task Force members noted that the improvements will be changing the grade in the road by re-paving the surface rather than re-constructing the road structure.

It was suggested that crosswalks be constructed with stamped asphalt, featuring the City's wave/brand. New sidewalk panels could also include artistic detail. It was agreed to review

the 2011 Town Centre Design Guidelines Study prepared by MMM Group Ltd. with regard to suggested infrastructure.

It was suggested that the current banner poles remain, but be painted to match the rest of the infrastructure.

The welcome to White Rock sign at North Bluff Avenue and Johnston Road will be replaced, as will the one on Marine Drive just west of King George Highway.


The next meeting will be at the call of the Chairperson.
