This mega drop-down tab will include links to local non-profit arts and cultural associations, easy access to information about City of White Rock programs, such as Artists Walk and the Busking program, up-to-date information on design competitions run by the City, and other relevant news to the local arts and cultural community.

“By adding arts and culture to our website as a top level navigation element, we are demonstrating that arts are indeed a priority to the City of White Rock,” said Mayor Wayne Baldwin.

“Our Arts Economic Task Force and Public Art Advisory Committee were very busy last year and now in 2013 we’re going to start seeing the fruits of their labour. I predict it will be an exciting year for the arts in White Rock,” he said.
