### PROPOSED BYLAWS 1997, 2014, 2015, AND 2016

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City of White Rock will hold a Public Hearing and Public Meeting in the City Hall COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 15322 Buena Vista Avenue, White Rock, B.C., on **MONDAY, APRIL 29, 2013 at 7:00 p.m.** in accordance with the *Local Government Act*. At the Public Hearing/Public Meeting, all persons who deem their interest in property is affected by the proposed bylaws shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions reflecting matters contained in the bylaws that are the subject of the Public Hearing/Meeting.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

- 1) BYLAW 1997:** "White Rock Zoning Bylaw, 2012, No. 2000, Amendment (CD-39 – 14310 Marine Drive) Bylaw, 2012, No. 1997"

**PURPOSE:** Bylaw No. 1997 proposes to rezone the subject property from RS-1 One-Unit Residential to a comprehensive development zone that would allow the subdivision of the subject lot into two similar-sized lots to enable the construction of two (2) homes.

**PURPOSE:** Bylaw No.'s 2014, 2015, and 2016 propose to amend the Official Community Plan Bylaw, Zoning Bylaw, and Land Use Contract No. 30 to allow for the construction of a twelve (12) storey multi-unit residential complex consisting of twelve (12) townhouse units and ninety-seven (97) apartment units at 1467 to 1519 Vidal Street.
