Re: Request for Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

The City of White Rock has processed your request for access to the following information pursuant to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the Act)*:

For 2017:

- 1. Total bylaw revenue from fines issued and as a percentage of total City revenues.*
- 2. Bylaw revenue as above, broken down by type of infraction (ie, parking: \$X; noise: \$X)*
- 3. Cost of bylaw enforcement.*

Access to this information is available. The total revenue from bylaw fines issued in 2017 was \$346,824. This is about 0.70% of total City revenue.

Fine revenue is broken down as follows:

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The 2017 direct operational cost of non-parking related enforcement was \$231,991. This includes bylaw officer costs and miscellaneous office expenses, but not financial administration or management.

I am unable to confirm the cost of parking-related bylaw enforcement as these costs are not tracked separately in the City's accounts.
