Dispatched to 15952 Russell ave. for an MVA. We arrived on scene and found 3 vehicles involved. During scene assessment I found there were 2 injuries. There was no rescue required but air bag was discharged. V1 was traveling north on Stevens toward Russell ave. V1 stopped at the stop sign but didn't realize it was not a 4 way stop. Sos. 22 stopped and drove through without looking both ways. V2 was driving east ward toward Stevens st. V2 drove into V1 at the intersection of Stevens and Russell. V2 after the collision drove into a parked Ram truck which was parked on north side of Russell.. V1 driver injured her L fore arm and V2 driver injured her sternum.
