Re: Request for Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act

The City of White Rock has reviewed your request for access to the following records pursuant to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the “Act”):

- *the total number of hours assigned to patrolling the Pier and Promenade by City of White Rock Bylaw Officers to enforce the No Dogs Allowed during the April 1st to September 30th season*
- *the total cost for those hours of the Bylaw Officers, who are relegated to patrolling the Promenade and Pier to enforce the No Dogs Allowed during the April 1st to September 30th season*
- *the total amount of hours and total costs for the Bylaws Officers assigned to enforce the relevant bylaws in the same areas from October 1st, 2020 to March 31st, 2021*
- *the total amount of Bylaw tickets handed out between April 1st and September 30th of this year regarding Dogs on the Promenade and the Pier*
- *the total amount of dog licenses valid and issued so far in 2021*

The specific hours or costs associated with patrolling dogs on the Pier and Promenade are not available. The City does not assign Bylaw Enforcement Officers specifically to the task of patrolling dogs on the Pier and Promenade. Observing the Pier and Promenade is just one task of many that Bylaw Enforcement Officers attend to while on patrol.

Statistics on bylaw ticketing and dog licensing are available. Twenty-six (26) bylaw tickets related to the presence of dogs on the Pier and Promenade were issued between April 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021. Eight-hundred seventy-two (872) dog licences have been issued in White Rock as of November 17.
